the hunger and thirst
caused by fasting.

DUA 3 | IF SOMEONE ANGERS YOU

I'm fasting, I'm fasting

Innee saa'im, innee saa'im

Did You Know?

When You are Fasting, and someone is rude this dua can be said out loud, or in silence as a self-reminder. It helps us to control the anger caused by hunger and thirst.



DUA 4 | BREAKING THE FAST



اللهم لك صمت
وعلى رزقك افطرت

O Allah, it is for you that I
observed the fast and from Your
blessings I break it

Allahouma laka simtou wa ala
rizkika aftartou

Did You Know?

There are a number of different duas we can say at meals. This reminds us that our food comes from Allah and is a great blessing from Him. The Prophet Muhammad used to break his fast with dates and water.

DUA 5 ENTERING THE MOSQUE

Saying this prayer reminds us of Allah's great kindness and mercy. It helps us to turn our attention towards Him as we enter His house of worship.

May Allah reward you with goodness

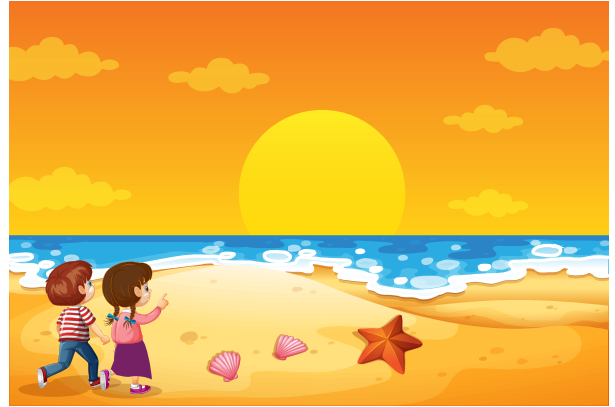
Jazak Allahu khayran
