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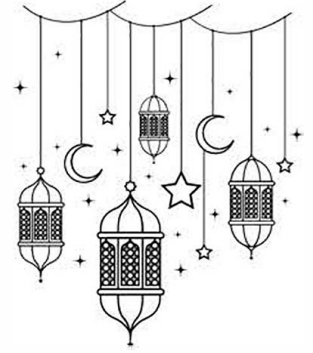
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# First 10 Days of Ramadan (Ashra of Mercy)

You are the best of the merciful." (23: 118)***

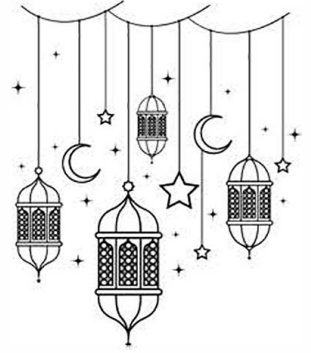

وَمَنْ يَعْمَلْ سُوءًا أَوْ يَظْلِمْ نَفْسَهُ ثُمَّ يَسْتَغْفِرِ اللَّهَ  
يَجِدِ اللَّهَ غَفُورًا رَحِيمًا

***"And whoever does a wrong or wrongs himself but then seeks forgiveness of Allah will find Allah Forgiving and Merciful." Surah An-Nisa (4:110)***

*A heartfelt prayer of Prophet Yunus (PBUH), seeking forgiveness and turning to Allah in repentance while in the belly of the whale.*

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ سُبْحَانَكَ إِنِّي كُنْتُ مِنَ الظَّالِمِينَ

**"There is no deity except You; Exalted are You. Indeed, I have been of the wrongdoers." (21:87)**

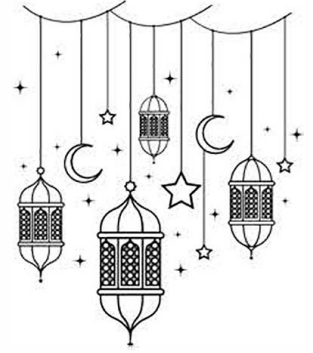

# Dua for Protection

*Prophet Muhammad ﷺ would recite a supplication in the evening and morning asking for protection from harm, seeking goodness, and refuge from Hell and the punishment of the grave.*

رب أعوذ بك من عذاب النار، وعذاب في القبر

“O Allah! I seek Your Protection from the torment of Hell-fire and the punishment of the grave.” (Riyad as-Salihin)
