
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First 10 Days of Ramadan (Ashra of Mercy)

(Surah Ash-Shura, 42:37)





Dua for Protection

Prophet Muhammad : would recite a supplication in the evening and morning asking for protection from harm, seeking goodness, and refuge from Hell and the punishment of the grave.



"O Allah! I seek Your Protection from the torment of Hell-fire and the punishment of the grave." (Riyad as-Salihin)
