Turn the First 10 Days of Dhul Hijjah Into Your Best Days With Allah

Deed	Why It's Important	Simple Ways to Do It
Five Daily Prayers	Most important obligation and foundation of worship	Pray on time, focus more in salah, pray in congregation if possible
Extra Voluntary Prayers	Brings you closer to Allah	Pray Tahajjud, Duha, or extra sunnah prayers
Fasting	Highly rewarded during these blessed days	Fast the first 9 days if able, especially the Day of Arafah
Day of Arafah Fast	Sins of two years are forgiven	Fast on the 9th of Dhul Hijjah
Quran Recitation	Increases guidance and connection with Allah	Read daily, reflect on meanings, set a page goal
Dhikr (Remembrance of Allah)	One of the easiest and most beloved deeds	Repeat "Allahu Akbar," "SubhanAllah," "Alhamdulillah," and "La ilaha illa Allah" often
Dua	Direct connection with Allah	Ask for forgiveness, guidance, and Jannah
Charity (Sadaqah)	Loved greatly by Allah in these days	Feed the poor, donate money, help struggling families
Helping Others	Acts of kindness are beloved to Allah	Help with bills, food, medicine, or emotional support
Repentance (Tawbah)	Cleanses sins and softens the heart	Make sincere istighfar and leave bad habits
Maintaining Family Ties	A major act of worship in Islam	Call relatives, forgive others, reconnect

Deed	Why It's Important	Simple Ways to Do It
Good Character	Heavy on the scale of deeds	Speak kindly, avoid arguments, be patient
Takbir	Sunnah of these blessed days	Frequently say: "Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar, La ilaha illa Allah..."
Qurbani (Sacrifice)	Sunnah of Eid al-Adha	Offer sacrifice if financially able
Seeking Knowledge	Helps strengthen faith and actions	Listen to Islamic reminders or read beneficial books
Avoiding Sins	Sins harm the heart especially in sacred times	Stay away from gossip, backbiting, and harmful habits

Prophet Ibrahim	Rabbana taqabbal minna innaka Antas- Sami'ul-'Aleem	"Our Lord, accept from us. Indeed You are the All-Hearing, All-Knowing."
	Rabbi-j'alni muqeemas- salati wa min dhurriyyati	"My Lord, make me and my descendants establish prayer."
	Rabbi-j'al hadhal balada aminan	"My Lord, make this city safe."
	Rabbanaghfir li wa liwalidayya wa lilmu'mineen	"Our Lord, forgive me, my parents, and the believers."
Prophet Muhammad ﷺ	Allahumma innaka 'afuwun tuhibbul 'afwa fa'fu 'anni	"O Allah, You are Most Forgiving and love forgiveness, so forgive me."
	Ya Muqallibal-quloob, thabbit qalbi 'ala deenik	"O Turner of hearts, keep my heart firm upon Your religion."
	Rabbana atina fid-dunya hasanah wa fil-akhirati hasanah wa qina 'adhaban- nar	"Our Lord, grant us good in this world and the Hereafter and protect us from the Fire."
	Allahumma a'inni 'ala dhikrika wa shukrika wa husni 'ibadatika	"O Allah, help me remember You, thank You, and worship You beautifully."
